#### **FURTHER INFORMATION REGARDING ITINERANT MUSIC LESSONS:**

- Itinerant Music lessons are held in the Music block, upstairs in the practice rooms.
- The Music block is part of KIWI whanau (orange buildings) next to the bus bay.
- Individual and group lessons (2 or 3 students per group) are available.
- All lessons are held once per week and run for 30 minutes, during school time.
- Your child should bring their instrument to school for their lesson. This can be stored
  in the Music storage room for the day. An amplifier is available for electric guitarists
  and bass players to use at school. Piano, keyboard and drum kit are also provided at
  school for lessons. If they are not able to bring their guitar to school, a guitar will be
  provided for the lesson.
- Your child is responsible for remembering to come to their lesson.

## SICKNESS:

If your child is sick and will miss their Itinerant Music lesson please email their teacher directly with 24 hours notice so you may re-schedule their lesson for a later date. Failure to provide adequate notice means our Itinerant teachers will not be able to schedule a make-up lesson for the missed lesson.

You are required to give 4 weeks notice if you wish to withdraw your child from Itinerant Music lessons.
